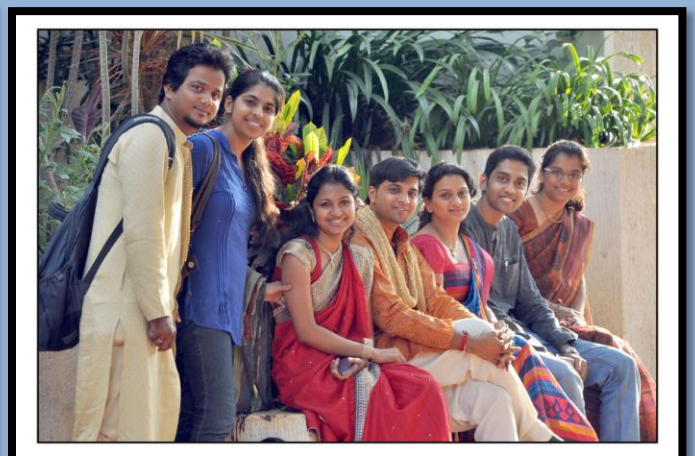


## Traditional Day Celebration at GBS Hubli
